

Bateen World Academy offers a wide range of subjects and has a broad curriculum provision. Students will also follow all components of the mandatory Ministry of Education (MOE) subjects which includes Arabic, Islamic, Social Studies and Moral Education which are typically taught in Native and Non Native groups.

Life outside the classroom will be rich and varied for Bateen World Academy students. Many opportunities will be available, including soccer, volleyball, basketball, swimming, vocal music, baking, drawing, drama, yearbook, mathematics, French, Spanish, Quran, just to name a few. We will offer ECA's (Extra Curricular Activities) for students from FS2 to 13. The ECA's will begin in September and the timings will be communicated at the beginning of the academic year.

Please note: School bus departure times are the same every day. Parents will be required to arrange alternative pick-up on the days students take part in ECA's.

Bring Your Own Device

In order to support learning whilst adhering to the latest health and safety guidelines, we would like to invite all students from Year 3 to Year 13 to "Bring your own device" (BYOD).

BYOD will ensure students are building on their increasing independence, whilst having access to their work anytime, anywhere. The innovative teaching and learning methods will be able to be transfered back to the physical classroom and ensure students continue to be able to express and engage in learning in diverse ways.

The use of devices in school will be carefully planned and monitored by staff and used to enhance the learning experience. Bateen World Academy operates a secure and closed network and the full details of safe use can be found when agreeing to the terms and conditions as part of the BYOD Policy. All students from Year 3 to Year 13 will be trained at an age appropriate level how to integrate technology into their everyday learning.

It is essential to emphasise that your child's learning is the key focus around this initiative and there will still be a huge focus on active learning where possible as well as speaking, listening, writing and drawing and that devices will be used mainly as a tool to access resources and record learning. Students will continue to learn away from their device and our highly skilled teaching staff will plan lessons very carefully to allow for this.

Bateen World Academy will be an Apple Distinguished School soon, so it is advised to buy latest apple device for better battery life, faster processing power and longevity.



Nutrition/Catering

Food Nation LLC. was established in 2016 to and the aim was to provide nutritious, innovative food offerings bursting with flavor to schools across the UAE. Food Nation uses only quality raw products and all products are made from scratch, ingredients are non-processed, additive free and use healthy fats over trans-fats that are found in many processed foods.

Food Nations, 'Eat Bright' programme creates products with specifically targeted nutrients to improve academic performance; ensuring essential nutrients, vitamins, minerals, proteins and healthy fats are included in our meals. Year 3 to Year 13 students can purchase their own food from the cafeteria or they can bring their own healthy packed lunch. In addition, we encourange all students to bring a refillable water bottle.

School Fees Cashless Payment Options

Dear Parents

We are writing to notify you about a change in the school's policy regarding tuition fee payments.

To help collect payments in an efficient and streamlined manner and provide convenience to both yourselves and our school teams, we will no longer be accepting any cash transactions for your child's school fees.

Below are the payment options now available to you:

- Bank Transfer Please include the Student Codes and Invoice References in the payment description fields and please send an email confirmation of the payment to the school's finance email address.
- Cheques Please put these in a sealed envelope with the Student Codes and Invoice References on the reverse of the cheque and submit it via the dedicated drop box placed at the school premises. Upon clearance of the cheque, a receipt will be issued to the registered email address within 3 working days.
- 'Payit' mobile phone application the UAE's first all-in-one digital wallet by First Abu Dhabi Bank (FAB) and available for download for free on iOS and Adroid devices.

The school will not be able to accept credit or debit card transactions.

We believe this change will benefit how our schools operate more efficiently to serve you and help reduce the need for handling or transporting cash.

For ease, invoices will be shared to your registered email address and will be available on the parent portal. We would kindly ask that fees are paid by the due date mentioned on the invoice.
