### IB Primary Years Programme (PYP)

A unique transdisciplinary, inquiry based approach to learning.

The PYP nurtures and develops young students as caring, active participants in a lifelong journey of learning.

Guided by six transdisciplinary themes of global significance, students deepen their learning by developing their conceptual understandings: strengthening their knowledge and skills across and beyond subject areas.

Through the inquiry-led, transdisciplinary framework, the PYP challenges students to think for themselves and take responsibility for their learning as they explore local and global issues and opportunities in real life contexts.

### I/GCSE's

From year 7, students study the English National Curriculum with an international dimension along with the Ministry of Education subjects.

In years 10 and 11 students will study the I/GCSE's (General Certificate of Secondary Education).

### **IB DP**

The best pre-university programme – including EE, TOK and CAS. Welcomed by all leading universities worldwide. International research shows that there are many benefits to choosing the IB DP over other 16-19 curricula.

For example: IB DP students are better able than their peers to cope with demanding workloads, manage their time and meet the expectations placed on them. Analysis of IB DP students in Canada, the UK and the USA found that the IB DP's extended essay improves students' approach to learning in higher education.
