At Bateen World Academy, the safety and security of our students is our top priority, to ensure a safe learning environment for all. We require all parents to wear their permanent yellow parent-guardian lanyard if access to the premises is needed. This includes access to the Primary School play area within the perimeter wall of the school.



Friday | 7:40am -12:00pm


Punctuality and Attendance:

- For years 7-13 ties or neck scarfs should be worn neatly, with shirts tucked in and top buttons fastened.
- School shoes must be plain black, without any coloured markings or contrasting soles (e.g., no white soles).
- If there are any temporary issues with uniform items, please write a short note in your child's planner so we're aware and can support appropriately.

We recognise and reward students who take a principled and responsible approach to wearing their uniform—house points are awarded for consistently meeting expectations!

Where reminders are needed, we may issue a short-term *uniform monitoring card* to help students stay on track with our standards.

Mobile Phones in School

Mobile Phones:

We would like to remind all students and parents that mobile phones are strictly prohibited on the Bateen World Academy premises. If mobile phones are visible, they will be confiscated and stored securely until the issue is resolved. School policy is that a level 2 written warning will be issued to any child who uses or is seen with their mobile phone on school site during school hours.

In cases of extenuating circumstances, where students need to contact home, they should speak to their form tutor or head of year in the first instance. If students need to contact home when leaving the school then there are two options.

- Politely ask reception if they can use the school phone to coordinate pick up.
- Exit the reception area and use their phone outside the school building.

Should your child be unwell and unable to attend school please email Attendance@albateenacademy.sch.ae and copy in your child's form tutor or class teacher to advise your child is not attending due to illness.

Day 1 - your child will be marked as 'Authorized Absence'

Day 2 and onwards – your child will be marked as 'Unauthorized Absence', until a sick certificate is presented. This will then be changed to 'Authorized Absence'.

Please do so by 7:30am on each day of absence.

Important Information from ADEK regarding automated attendance messages

Please be advised the ADEK system will report any unexplained absences from the start of the academic year.

If you receive an alert, it does not mean your child has been absent for the last three consecutive days, but that they have had 3 days of unauthorized absence from the start of term.
